Mather Hospital President, Setauket Resident Named Chair of Nassau-Suffolk Hospital Council

August 1, 2016 (Hauppauge, NY) – *Setauket, New York resident and president of John T. Mather Memorial Hospital (Port Jefferson, New York) Kenneth Roberts*, was named chair of the Nassau-Suffolk Hospital Council (NSHC) at the group's Annual Meeting held July 13, 2016. His two-year term expires in 2018.

This is Roberts second time as chair of the Nassau-Suffolk Hospital Council, the organization that serves as the collective voice for Long Island's 23 not-for-profit and public hospitals.

He is secretary and member of Island Nursing and Rehabilitation Center and INRC Services Corporation and a member of the board of directors of Harbor View Medical Services.

A Fellow of the American College of Healthcare Executives, he is the recipient of the Monsignor Thomas J. Hartman Humanitarian Award and both the Outstanding CEO and Healthcare Hero Awards from the *Long Island Business News*.
